

Declaration by the High Representative on behalf of the EU on the alignment of certain third countries concerning restrictive measures against the leadership of the Transnistrian region of the Republic of Moldova

On 29 October 2020, the Council adopted Decision (CFSP) 2020/1586^[1].

The Council Decision renews the existing restrictive measures until 31 October 2021.

This Decision shall be reviewed after six months.

The Candidate Countries the Republic of North Macedonia, Montenegro and Albania^[2], and the EFTA countries Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway, members of the European Economic Area, as well as Ukraine and Georgia align themselves with this Council Decision.

They will ensure that their national policies conform to this Council Decision.

The European Union takes note of this commitment and welcomes it.
